

**CITY OF LAGRANGE, GEORGIA
RESIDENTIAL ELECTRIC SERVICE
Revised July 1, 2018**

AVAILABILITY:

Throughout the City's service area from existing lines of adequate capacity.

APPLICABILITY:

Residential service is available for individually metered residences, condominiums, mobile homes, and apartments which provide independent and permanent facilities complete for living, sleeping, eating, cooking, and sanitation.

TYPE OF SERVICE:

Single or three phase, 60 hertz, at a standard voltage.

MONTHLY RATE:

WINTER - October through May

Base Charge.....	\$ 20.00
First 650 KWH.....	7.000 cents/KWH
Next 350 KWH.....	6.000 cents/KWH
Over 1000 KWH.....	5.500 cents/KWH

SUMMER - June through September

Base Charge.....	\$20.00
First 650 KWH.....	7.000 cents/KWH
Next 350 KWH.....	8.000 cents/KWH
Over 1000 KWH.....	10.300 cents/KWH

PURCHASE POWER ADJUSTMENT:

The amount calculated at the above rate will be increased under the provisions of the City's Purchased Power Adjustment Schedule.

Minimum Monthly Bill: \$20.00

LEVELIZED BILLING OPTION:

Residential customers with a good credit history may be offered the option of levelized billing. Details of this billing option are available from the City's Customer Service Division.

SENIOR CITIZEN-LOW INCOME ASSISTANCE:

Qualifying customers certified by the City will be eligible for a discount on their monthly bill.

ROUND-UP:

Customers that do not notify the City of their desire to opt-out will have the total of their utility charges rounded up to the next whole dollar. The proceeds of this round-up will be used to assist low income customers pay their utility bills or as otherwise directed by the LaGrange City Council.

CONTINUITY OF SERVICE:

The City does not guarantee an uninterrupted or undisturbed supply of electric service. The City will not be responsible for any loss or damage resulting from the interruption or disturbance of service for any cause other than gross negligence of the City. The City will not be liable for any loss of profits or other consequential damages resulting from the use of service or any interruption or disturbance of service. The City shall not in any way be responsible for the transmission, use, or control of electrical energy beyond the point of connection to the customer's premises.
